
Board of Directors Meetings

Indian Valley School District Unveils New Stadium

Thanks to the voters of the Indian Valley School District, this fall the BRAVES were proud to unveil their newest facility. The stadium features a new allweather track, a new football field featuring field turf, and a spacious field house serving a wide range of sports. The Indian Valley School District now has all new modern school buildings and this much needed sport facility completes the final piece that proudly promotes our district. Just as the stadium is the final piece for the BRAVES community, we now have the two final pieces to compliment the stadium. To honor Larry Holmes a Victory Bell Memorial has been erected by Indian Valley supporters in honor of the late Larry Holmes and Indian Valley Foundation has donated sideline benches.



Indian Valley Foundation Donates Benches

The Board of Directors of the Indian Valley Foundation discussed donating something to the stadium which would be beneficial for use while also promoting the Indian Valley Foundation. Several ideas were considered for this project. After conferring with district administrators, a decision was made to purchase sideline aluminum bench seating for the football field. Two 12' benches and a 15' medical bench was purchased for each side of the field. A custom sign, designed by USP Signs, was attached to the back of each medical bench which reads "Donated by Indian Valley Foundation." The bench seating fills a need for the district at this beautiful facility while fulfilling our desire to promote the Foundation for many years to come.



Pavroll Deductions

It has been a rough year for everyone including Indian Valley Foundation but yet we were able to give \$30,000 in scholarships to 26 deserving graduates. Our main fundraisers, the Gala and our steak dinner, were not held in 2020 so any help would be greatly appreciated. Indian Valley Schools have 211 teachers and staff and one way to help us is to use payroll deductions.
